Abstract

Historically, cricket allowed local populations

to take the British imposition of colonial rule and adapt it into their own cultural practices. Similarly, my goal for this project is to find ways to effectively represent the numerous immigrant communities on my chosen site in Dallas, Texas, while integrating with other local populations and sports culture.

To do so, I will design a cricket stadium that is representative of these various groups. I will explore architectural languages of pre and postcolonial sports architecture, as well as the everyday immigrant experience, and their expressions of material culture in their neighborhoods.

Together, I will challenge the architectural primacy of the stadium as an extension of Western-inspired modernist architecture. Through a combination of architectural programs, events, and symbols, I plan to design a stadium that is reflective of a broader diaspora, while being responsive to other local conditions.

- -T20 matches are often played as part of tournaments like the Indian Premier League (IPL), Big Bash League (BBL), and ICC World Twenty 20.



- 8. Practice nets: Enclosed areas where players can practice their batting, bowling, and fielding.
- 9. Hospitality areas: VIP boxes, lounges, and restaurants where guests can comfortably watch the game.
- 10. Dressing rooms: The area where players can rest and relax during breaks in the game.

- 4. Practice facilities: Adequate practice nets, bowling machines, and other training equipment to help players prepare for the match.

I had a big design. It was for a cricket stadium in Frisco, Texas. My vision went beyond sports. I saw it as a vibrant venue for the community. The design included more than just the stadium. There were elements like a restaurant and a cricket park. Also, this cricket museum was added to the mix. Not to mention, residential and commercial spaces come into play, along with hotels. My aim? To draw in not only enthusiasts of cricket but also individuals looking for something different and engaging. The stadium was meant to be more than that. A destination for all sorts of people was the goal. So, I threw in various amenities and attractions—like that restaurant, park, and museum—to catch their interest. Families should find it appealing. Tourists too. And residents should not feel left out. With both residential areas and places for businesses plus hotels around—the venue would always be bustling all year round; it would foster community spirit and vibrancy among everyone involved or just passing through. Now, about its location—it is right there in busy Frisco, Texas, yet my design wanted something unique—a small-town essence within this complex structure. Traditional architecture played its part here, along with green spaces sprinkled around; they were critical elements intended to bring out nostalgia—a sense of nostalgia, you would say—and charm, too; it makes it feel welcoming—an intimate space amidst the vast city landscape, setting it apart from other sports venues and transforming it into an unmatched destination within Frisco.
